November 18, 1917 - October 14, 2009

Marjorie Ice, age 91, of Murphysboro, passed away at 11:55 a.m., Wednesday, October 14, 2009, at the Rehab and Care Center of Jackson County in Murphysboro, Illinois.

Her body has been cremated. A memorial service will be held at 11 a.m. Monday, October 19, 2009 at Pettett Funeral Home in Murphysboro, with Father Gary Gummingsheimer officiating.

Marjorie was born on November 18, 1917, in Chew Magna, England, to the late Tom and Archie Weaver.

She married Paul Wayne Ice, a U.S. Army Soldier from West Frankfort, in August, 1946, in Bristol, England. They came back to the United State after the World War II living mostly in West Frankfort and Murphysboro, Illinois. Her husband, Paul, preceded her in death in 1977.

Marjorie drove an ambulance for the British Civil Defense and Courier and Supply Trucks for the U.S. Army during World War II. After locating in Murphysboro, she worked at Holden Hospital in Carbondale in the Insurance Department. She also worked as an Avon Representative for many years.
