On February 27, 2023 Mary Lynn Nielsen-Powell went to her Heavenly home.

She had reached the age of 70. Mary was born in St. Andrew's Hospital in Murphysboro on January 17, 1953, the first born of four girls to Ernst R. and Imogene (Sumner) Nielsen.

After graduating from Murphysboro Township High School in 1971, Mary obtained an Associate's Degree in Nursing from Belleville Area College (now SWIC). In 1989 a BS degree was earned from SIU-C.

Several decades were spent as an RN working at Memorial Hospital of Carbondale and St. Joseph Memorial Hospital of Murphysboro.

On January 10, 1987 Mary was united in marriage to James "Larry" Powell at the Carbondale Church of God. Larry passed away in 2019.
