Michael D. Lane, 71, of Murphysboro, passed away at 10:25 p.m. Tuesday, October 28, 2014, at Barnes-Jewish Hospital in St. Louis, Missouri.

Michael was born on April 8, 1943, in Murphysboro, Illinois, to Winfred Lane, Jr. and Leora (Humphries) Lane.

He served in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam Conflict.

Michael retired as the Area Operations Supervisor with Ameren-CIPS, after working thirty two years.

Mr. Lane was a member of St. Andrew Catholic Church in Murphysboro, a member of the Elk's Lodge # 572 and a member and past commander of the American Legion Paul Stout Post # 127.
