Nancy Gunn, age 83, of Anna, passed away Thursday, Oct. 9, 2025 at home.

She was born July 1, 1942 to John G. & Ruby (Menees) Hubbs in Anna, Illinois.

She was united in marriage to W. Leon Gunn on June 5, 1976. He preceded her in death Oct. 11, 2024.

Nancy was a member of the First Evangelical Presbyterian Church of Anna where she was active in the Women's Association, Women's Ministries, Vacation Bible School and a Sunday School teacher.
