Nancy Hellmer Korando, age 70, of Murphysboro, passed away at 11:32 a.m. Thursday, November 23, 2006, at St. Joseph Memorial Hospital in Murphysboro.

Nancy was born on July 16, 1936, in Jackson County, Illinois, to Fred Pflasterer and Helen (Nehring) Pflasterer.
