Nina Goines, 91, of Wetaug, passed away Saturday, Mar. 28, 2020 at her home with her family by her side.

She was born Sept. 7, 1928 in Wetaug, the daughter of Louis and Cora (Severs) Gulley. She was married on Nov. 17, 1947 to Wilborn Goines. He preceded her in death Dec. 31, 2005.

Nina was a member of the Wetaug Church of Christ.
