Nora Virginia Duncan went home to be with the Lord Sunday, March 25, 2018 at Ratliff Care Center surrounded by her family. She was 95 years old.

She was born on May 24, 1922 in Delta, Missouri to Roy and Rose Gilder. She married Orville Duncan on December 21, 1940 in Cape Girardeau.

A resident of Delta for the majority of her life, Virginia was a member of the First Baptist church of Delta for 75 years. She enjoyed singing in the choir and serving in the nursing home and shut in ministries. She was a member of the Order of the Eastern Star for 69 years.
