Pamela Ellen (nee Henrikson) Kasky, age 67, of Murphysboro, passed away peacefully at home surrounded by family and friends on Sunday, June 26, 2022.

For years she fought cancer; breast cancer in 1990; ovarian cancer in 1994, 2011, 2018 and finally succumbed to AML (Acute Myeloid Leukemia) in 2022. Her resolve to fight cancer tooth and nail at every turn has earned her the family nickname of "Warrior Queen."

Pam attended St. Eulalia Grade School in Maywood, Illinois and graduated from Proviso East High School. She then attended Triton College in River Grove, Illinois. Pam then left Chicago to receive her Bachelor of Science Degree from SIU-Carbondale in Outdoor Recreation in 1978. Her Denny's Restaurant career began in Oak Park, Illinois and she transferred that work experience to the now closed Carbondale Denny's and finally retired in 2013.

Her interests included fishing, camping, boating, bicycling, and working as a counselor at Little Grassy Girl Scout Camp. Her grandchildren were the loves of her life.

Survivors include her husband of forty-two years, John Kasky; son, Michael; grandchildren, Austin, Victoria, Trevor and Kinsley; son, David and wife, Jessica; grandchildren, Nathan and Eli; siblings, Lori Vierneisel of North Port, Florida, Gayle Kurtzrock of Perryville, Missouri and Scott Henrikson of Laguna Niguel, California.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Donald and Lorraine (Kubistal) Henrikson
