Paul E. Naas, age 87, passed away at 2:45 p.m. Tuesday, September 19, 2006, at the Veteran's Administration Medical Center in Marion.

Paul was born on February 28, 1919, in Eldorado, Illinois, to Frederick Naas and Anna (Bauer) Naas.

He served in the U.S. Navy, and he was a combat veteran of Iwo Jima. Mr. Naas was a member of St. Andrew Catholic Church in Murphysboro, Knights of Columbus, the American Legion Post # 127, and V.F.W. Post # 7190.

He was a wood worker and a very good piano player.

Mr. Naas was the former owner of the West Town Shell Station in Carbondale for almost 25 years.

Paul married Martha Young, on June 26, 1947, in Eldorado, Illinois, and she survives.
