Philip C. Hodges, age 69 of Cairo, passed away on Monday, January 23, 2023 at 10:11 AM at Life Care Center in Cape Girardeau, Missouri.

He was born on October 1, 1953 to Herbert and Opal (Lucas) Hodges in Cairo, Illinois. He married Doris Davis on November 8, 1973. She survives.

He was a 1971 graduate of Cairo High School. He served on the Cairo City Council for two terms where he oversaw the Fire, Parks, and Street Departments over the course of his tenure. He was a businessman who lived to work and had several businesses throughout his career. He started Fill-Up Mart, INC. in 1982, Butcher Block, INC. in 1984, and Fill-Up Mart Vending in 1987. Philip attended the Salvation Army Church as a youth. He later was of the Baptist faith.

Survivors include his wife, sons, Bryan Hodges and Glenn (Alisha) Hodges, mother, Opal Hodges, grandsons, Nicholas and Zachary Hodges, granddaughter, Violet Hodges, sisters, Janice (Ronald) Sutton, Kaye Allison, and Vickie Caldwell, brothers, Michael and Byron Hodges.
