Randall Childers, 81, of Cairo, Illinois, died on Tuesday, September 12, 2017 at Southeast Hospital in Cape Girardeau, Missouri.

Randall was born in Anna, Illinois to Robert James and Dorothy Blanche (Sullivan) Childers. He married his high school sweetheart, Connie Hall, on October 17, 1959 and she predeceased him in death on June 23, 2015.

As a young man, Randall worked at Riverside, then full-time until 1954; he then worked at Blankenship as parts salesman and then as route man with Auto Fisher Tire and Parts, working until the time of his death. Randall served in the National Guard. He and Connie camped and loved fishing and hunting, as well as woodworking and he was an amateur photographer.
