Rebah Faulkner, age 93 of Carbondale, formerly of Cairo, passed away at 7:40 pm on Tuesday, May 27, 2014 in the Rehabilitation and Care Center of Jackson County.

She was born August 25, 1920 to B.T. and Lula (Hudgen) Long in Manila, AR.
