Richard Dickerson, 87 of Ullin, died at 4:24 AM on Sunday, November 3, 2019, with his wife, Joan by his side at Southeast Hospital in Cape Girardeau, Missouri.

He was born on February 20, 1932 in Elco, the son of J.P. and Frieda (Smithey) Dickerson. He married Sybille Joan Gurley on June 24, 1961.

Richard made his career in the automobile industry. He along with his father and brother, Clinton, purchased a dealership formerly known as Wilkins Chevrolet Sales in Ullin, Illinois in 1956. Together they formed a new dealership known as Dickerson Chevrolet. On June 10, 1961, J.P. Dickerson passed away, leaving the two sons as partners in the business which continued until their retirement in 1997 after 40 years in business.
