Robbin Christopher Franklin, 31, of McClure, formerly of Reno, Nevada died at 9:10AM Wednesday, May 29, 2019 in Thebes.

He was born December 28, 1987 in Carbondale to Robin Kim and Tracey Lynn (Harrell) Franklin.

Robbin served his country for 8 years in United States Army with a rank of SPC. During which time he did two tours of duty, one in Iraq and one in Afghanistan. He was a part of the 101st Airborne out of Fort Campbell, KY, the "Rakkasans" platoon.
