Robert Leon Piltz, age 84, of Murphysboro and formerly of Melbourne, FL, passed away at 5:50 a.m. Saturday, September 9, 2006, at the Rehab and Care Center of Jackson County in Murphysboro.

Robert was born on April 14, 1922, in Murphysboro, to Conrad and Ollie (Rhyne) Piltz.

He worked in the coal mines in this area and then went into the U.S. Army during World War II .

Robert married Ethel Delaney and she preceded him in death on February 2, 2002.

Mr. Piltz was a member of the Palmdale Presbyterian Church in Melbourne, FL, and had been attending St. Peter's United Church of Christ in Murphysboro.
