



## Robert Ward "R.W." McAlister

October 5, 1972 - October 7, 2021

Robert Ward "R.W." McAlister, age 49, of Jonesboro, passed away at 8:16 p.m. on Thursday, October 7, 2021 at Southeast Missouri Hospital.

He was born on October 5, 1972, the son of Bob and Kristie (Dillow) McAlister.

R.W. served as minister of the Anna Church of Christ. He worked as an Ag Instructor at Southeast Missouri State University and also a farmer. R.W. also served on the school board at Jonesboro Elementary for several years.

Survivors include his wife, Renee McAlister; his daughters, Katie (Elijah) Boren and Holly (Lee) Tellor; a son, Jason McAlister; his mother, Kristie McAlister; a brother, Bryan (Mendy) McAlister; several uncles, aunts, nieces, nephews, cousins, friends, and other relatives.

R.W. was preceded in death by his father, Robert (Bob) McAlister; a sister, Amy McAlister; his paternal grandparents, Robert and Irene McAlister; and his maternal grandparents, Ward and Virgie Dillow.













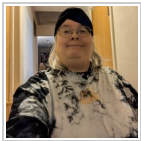
