Robert E. Reedy Jr, of Sikeston, MO died August 31, 2022 at the age of 78.

Here he met his wife, Sharan Kay Palmer, and they settled down in Sikeston, MO, where they lived until her death on April 14, 1997.

Mr. Reedy taught music, predominantly at Kelly Public Schools, for almost 30 years and drove the school bus for both Kelly and Sikeston Public Schools for almost 50 years total. Other than a passion for music, Mr. Reedy was part of the online community for both Train and Flight Simulator and the racing game Live for Speed.

He is survived by two daughters, Jennifer Olson of Sikeston and Bethany Reedy of Memphis, TN; two grandsons, Anthony and Thomas; and a brother, Gary Reedy of Colorado.
