Ross Lyndall Reiman, of Murphysboro, passed away at 8:03 a.m. Saturday, March 12, 2011, at the St. Joseph Memorial Hospital in Murphysboro, Illinois.

Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Tuesday, March 15, 2011, at Pettett Funeral Home with Rev. Ron Heiman officiating and burial at Pleasant Grove Memorial Park. Friends may call from 5 to 8 p.m. Monday and Tuesday until 11 a.m. at the funeral home. Ross was born on April 5, 1934, in the Levan Township of Jackson County, Illinois, to Julius "Jack" and Rosa (Imhoff) Reiman. After graduation in 1952 from Murphysboro Township High School, he farmed with his parents. He retired after 31 years of service as a Murphysboro U.S. Rural Postal Carrier, seventeen years as a substitute and fourteen years as a regular (Route 4) Carrier.

Mr. Reiman was a member and former deacon of the Camp Creek Baptist Church in Murphysboro.

In Murphysboro on November 26, 1955, he married the daughter of Tommy and Wlima (Morrison) Adams of Sand Ridge Township, Shirley Mae Adams,

his surviving wife of 55 years.
