She loved music, and will be remembered listening to current pop, tapping her feet along with the beat. She would say she didn't really notice or care about the lyrics, she was there for the rhythm. She loved visiting with family, long phone calls with old friends, watching television and reading magazines. Her mind was sharp and she was always informed on current events, celebrities and trending gossip. She was the family historian, being able to remember all names, dates and details of consequence. Hours would fly by in Ruth's company, she was a skilled conversationalist and would never run out of things to discuss.

Ruth and Jack observed 65 years of marriage when he passed in 2018. They say grief is a reflection of love and Ruth loved Jack so strongly and deeply that life without him was never quite the same.
