Scott Matthew Pewo, 47, of Dongola, died at 9:54 am on Sunday, May 1, 2016 at St. Louis University Hospital in St. Louis, MO.

He was born May 18, 1968 in Vancouver, WA, the son of Duane and Virginia (Hawkins) Pewo. He married Amy Fox on May 23, 2012.

Scott worked as a factory work and dietary aid at Anna Rehab & Nursing Center. He enjoyed fishing, camping and loved to cook. His most precious time was spent with his grandbaby who he loved dearly. Scott also served his country in the United States Army holding a rank as SPC. He displayed an act of heroism on February 25, 1991, when a scud missile impacted into the barracks warehouse in Dhahran, Saudi Arabia. He demonstrated bravery without regard for his personal safety, while rescuing soldiers from the flames and the discharging ammunition. His selfless acts saved soldier's lives and reflects great credit on the US Army soldier.

Survivors include his wife, Amy Pewo of Dongola; son, Adam Crowell of Alto Pass; daughter, Cierra Crowell of Cobden; granddaughter, Makaylee Asa of Cobden; nephews, Matthew Joshua Pewo and Nicholas Daniel Pewo both of Portland, OR; nieces, Ariel Barker and Cooper Dillow both of Dongola; sister-in-law and brother-in-law, Pamela (Doug) Dillow of Dongola; father-in-law and mother-in-law, Ralph (Shirley) Fox of Alto Pass; many other relatives and

friends.

He was preceded in death by his parents and sister, Tania Michele Pewo.

Visitation for Scott Matthew Pewo will be Thursday, May 5, 2016 from 5:00pm to 8:00pm at Crain Funeral Home in Dongola.

Funeral services will be at 1:00pm Friday, May 6, 2016 at the funeral home with Gregory Etherton officiating. Interment will follow at Friendship Cemetery with full military honors accorded by the Anna VFW Carroll P. Foster Post 3455 and the Illinois Honor Guard.

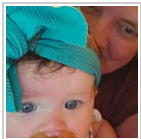

Scott, you are the first of us unto the breach, scout the way and when we meet again, we will be Kings of the Wild Frontier. There will be trouble in Paradise.

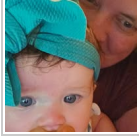
