Sheryl Hinchcliff, 75 years old, passed away at 9:15 am on Sunday July 20, 2020, in Portland, OR with her 3 daughters by her side.

Sheryl was born in Chicago Illinois on July 4th, 1945 to Leonard and Louise Horecker (Pevsner). She married Bill Hinchcliff, Jr. on June 12th, 1964 and they shared 52 years of marriage before Bill passed away in 2016.

Sheryl moved to Portland Oregon in 2017 to be closer to family and was beloved by the caring staff at Revere Court Memory Care facility. Sheryl lived in Spring Arbor for 40 years in a house she and Bill built. She cherished her neighbors' friendship. Her family is eternally grateful for the kind and generous support they gave to Sheryl throughout her life and especially during her illness.

Sheryl is survived by her 3 daughters, Leah Hinchcliff (Nancy Breaux) of Portland OR, Laurie Stoll (Richard) of Bolingbrook IL, and Lynda Lentini (Steve) of Plainfield IL; Sisters Leslie Hankinson (Tom), Beth Dotson (Thomas), Julie Horecker, and Leni Pender (Abe). 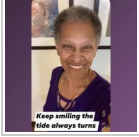
