April 1, 1944 - July 12, 2006

Stephen Lawrence House, M.D., age 62, of Carbondale, passed away at 10:00 a.m. Wednesday, July 12, 2006, at his residence in Carbondale. His body has been cremated and a memorial service will be held at a later date. Pettett Funeral Home is in charge of the arrangements. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to the Hospice of Southern Illinois, Inc. or to the Carbondale Unitarian Fellowship.

Stephen was born on April 1, 1944, in Atlanta, GA, to E. Lawrence House and Grace Moore House.

He graduated with high honors in 1965 from the Hamilton College in Clinton, NY, and in 1969, he graduated with high honors from the McGill University of Medicine in Montreal, Quebec, Canada. His medical training included general cardiovascular and thoracic surgery and family practice medicine.

Dr. House was a lieutenant Commander in U.S. Navy and served on the U.S.S. Oriskany in 1975 and 1976. He was an attending surgeon at the U.S. Naval Hospital in Oakland, CA in 1976 and 1977.

He is a member of the Carbondale Unitarian Fellowship.

Stephen married Annette McConnell on November 16, 2004, in Murphysboro, and she survives.

Other survivors include his mother in DeLand, FL; seven children, two grandchildren, and one brother David House in Ocala, FL.

He was preceded in death by his father.
