Thomas H. “Tommy” Parham, 88, of Paducah, KY, formerly of Cairo, died at 4:00 a.m., Saturday, October 3, 2020, at The Ray and Kay Eckstein Hospice Care Center in Paducah.

Tommy was born June 3, 1932 in Wickliffe, the son of Thomas Avery Parham and Georgia Harris Parham. He married Emma Jean Lang who survives.

Tommy was born and raised in Wickliffe. He served in the United States Army and the United States Air Force in the Electric Maintenance Squadron.
