Timothy "Tim" J. Herring, 45, of Murphysboro, passed away at 5:36 a.m. Tuesday, May 13, 2014, at Barnes-Jewish Hospital in St. Louis, Missouri.

Timothy was born on November 8, 1968, in Carbondale, Illinois, to Jack and Sandy (Mileur) Herring.

He was a member of the Plumber and Pipefitters Local # 160 of Murphysboro, and was working at SIU-Carbondale as a pipefitter.

Mr. Herring was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Murphysboro.

His greatest love was to play ball with his kids. He had enjoyed playing fast pitch softball for many years, travelling and playing for area teams all over the United States.
