Tyler E. Marquith, 10, and Nicholas E. Marquith, 8, of Gorham, passed away on Thursday evening, June 25, 2015, at St. Joseph Memorial Hospital in Murphysboro.

Tyler Eugene Marquith was born on March 12, 2005, in Carbondale and Nicholas Edward Marquith was born on June 10, 2007, in Marion, to Brad and Deanna (Rendleman) Marquith.

The brothers were both members of Murdale Baptist Church in Carbondale and participated in the Awana's Children Ministry. They both participated in Upward Basketball.

Tyler had just finished fourth grade and had just completed baseball camp and took piano lessons. Nicholas had just finished second grade and had participated in Upward Soccer. They loved being boys and they both went together.
