Vivian D. Morris, age 88, of Cape Girardeau, died at 4:20 PM, Sunday, June 1, 2014 at Life Care Center in Cape Girardeau.

She was born on August 25, 1925 in rural Graham County, Kansas to Clifford and Gladys Glee Cross Acheson. She married Paul M. Morris on August 24, 1952. He preceded her in death on April 8, 1986.

Vivian taught school for 40 years. She began her career in a one room schoolhouse in Kansas and retired in 1988 from L.J. Schultz Middle School in Cape Girardeau where she taught math. She often helped at the family business, Cape Color World.

She was an active member and elder of Abbey Road Christian Church in Cape Girardeau where she held many board positions throughout the years. Vivian enjoyed spending time with her family, especially her grandchildren. She was an excellent ping pong player.

She is survived by 1 son, David G. Morris (Kathryn L.) of Cape Girardeau, 1 daughter, Nita Eichman (Ivan) of Jackson, 4 grandchildren; Joseph Morris of Naples, FL, Joshua and Abigail Morris both of Cape Girardeau and Zane Eichman of Jackson, nieces, nephews, other relatives and many friends.

She was preceded in death by her husband, parents, 5 sisters; Lola Stubblefield, Esther Acheson, Twila Criswell, Phyllis Lefmann and Alberta Eichman and 1 brother, Alvin Acheson.
