



## Wallace Kohlfeld

October 4, 1920 - June 3, 2007

Wallace F. "Wally" Kohlfeld, age 86, of Murphysboro, passed away at 10:35 a.m. Sunday, June 3, 2007 at Helia Healthcare in Energy, IL.

Wallace was born on October, 4, 1920, in Apple Creek, MO to Carl Kohlfeld and Dora (Trapp) Kohlfeld.

Mr. Kohlfeld retired from the C.I.P.S. power plant in Grand Tower, where he worked as a welder. He had also worked as a welder after the bombing of Pearl Harbor, Hawaii.
