August 19, 1931 - February 12, 2017

Walter Leroy "Roy" Littlefield, 85, of Cape Girardeau died Sunday, February 12, 2017 at his home.

He was born on August 19, 1931 in Las Cruces, NM to Walter Leroy and Grace Harriet Dinwiddie Littlefield. He married Patricia Steinborn on June 11, 1999.

As a young man, Roy followed the rodeo circuit as a bull rider until the Korean War began. At that time, he enlisted in the United States Army serving in Korea from 1951 to 1953. During his time there, he was selected as driver for Gen. Lionel McGarr, assistant commander of the 2nd Infantry Division.

After his service to our country, Roy spent 38 years in the Baltimore, MD area working as a heavy equipment operator. After retiring, he enjoyed many hobbies, especially gardening and raising cattle.

Survivors include his wife Patricia Littlefield of Cape Girardeau; 2 daughters, Elizabeth "Roni" Roinell Lynch (Timothy A.) and Dena Louise Nahi and 1 son, Walter L. Littlefield, III all of Bel Air, MD.

He was preceded in death by his parents.

Visitation will be held from 10:00 AM until the time of service Wednesday, February 15 at Crain Funeral Home in Cape Girardeau.

Funeral services for Walter "Roy" Littlefield will be held at 11:00 AM Wednesday at the funeral home with Rev. Stan Hargis officiating. Interment with full military honors will follow at St. Mary's Cemetery in Cape Girardeau.
