



William (Bill) Harvey Rose

May 8, 1943 - August 18, 2018

William (Bill) Harvey Rose, PhD., 75, passed away on August 18, 2018, in Barnes-Jewish Hospital in St. Louis, Missouri.

William was born on May 8, 1943, to Orval "Bud" Rose and Norine (Broulliette) Rose.

He served in the U.S. Navy during the Vietnam Conflict on the USS Mariano G. Vallego, SSBN # 658, a deep sea nuclear submarine, which port was at Pearl Harbor. In this Sea Lab Commission, he served with aquanaut Scott Carpenter, who was one of the original Mercury astronauts and second man in orbit. He also served with Brad Mooney, who was his commanding officer of the Sea Lab Commission. Mr. Mooney later won a Nobel Peace Price in Science.

Dr. Rose received his PhD. in Psychology. His main counseling was with families, who had a terminally ill child. He also for the U.S. Government counseled American Indians.

He was preceded in death by his life partner Thomas Schlunz.

Bill is survived by four sisters Elizabeth Richmond (Richard Dickerman) of Piedmont, MO, Rebecca (Ron) Bryant of Makanda, Janet Layne of

Murphysboro, and Mary (Jack) Johnson of Metropolis; and many nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by one sister Mildred Klankey and his parents.

His body was cremated.

Gravesite Military services will be conducted by the Paul Stout American Legion Post # 127 at Mt. Joy Cemetery at 11 a.m. Saturday, June 1, 2019.
