William Craig Hinde, 86, died August 5, 2023 of complications from cancer. Craig was born on July 11, 1937 in the farm home of his parents near Storm Lake, Iowa to W. Kenneth and Pearl (Hussey) Hinde. He married Janice Campbell in 1959; they recently celebrated their 64th wedding anniversary. He was preceded in death by his parents and a grandson, Steven Ronk.

He is survived by his wife Jan, four children, Susan Lynn Hinde of Harvest, AL; John Kenneth (Sara) Hinde of Murphysboro, IL; Carolyn Janette Campbell of Tinley Park, IL; and Grant Douglas (Jill) Hinde of Albion, MI; five grandchildren, Shelli Ronk of Knoxville, TN; Dylan Hinde of Royal Oak, MI; Daniel (Niki) Hinde of Marshall, MI; Cayden Hinde and Carlisle Hinde, both of Murphysboro, IL. He is also survived by three great grandchildren, Gabriel Ronk of Harvest, AL; Murphy Jean Hinde and Miles Jack Hinde, both of Marshall, MI.

Craig attended elementary and high school at Providence Consolidated School in Sulphur Springs, Iowa and was valedictorian of his high school class in 1955. He attended college at Buena Vista and then at Iowa State University, Ames where he was graduated in 1960. He majored in both Agricultural Business and Tele communicative Arts (Radio, Television and Film). He began his career by giving daily farm commodity reports on radio and television. Following graduation he served in the Iowa National Guard and later in the U.S. Navy reserve. He began his career as a film writer, director and editor of documentary, educational, and corporate films. He won 21 national awards for his films while working for Southern Illinois University and, later, his own media business, Maplewood Productions.

Craig's avocation was in the dramatic arts. He was a co-founder of the Stage Company community theater in 1982 and appeared on stage in roles in over 25 plays, plus directing others and serving as president, treasurer and other offices in the management of the company. He was instrumental in helping the Stage Company renovate and move in to the Varsity Center in 2008 and served 11 years on the Varsity Center for the Arts Board of Directors. In 2017 he was honored with a celebration at the theater denoting his many years of being instrumental at the Stage Company. He was also active in Green Earth, serving as president, and Rotary Club.

He was adept at story-telling and also loved golf, following in his father's footsteps in those pursuits. He enjoyed playing with the Hickory Ridge senior golfers in Carbondale, and enjoyed playing golf courses around the country where his wife would accompany him. He cherished his family and was a loving husband, proud father and grandfather.

A Memorial Service will be Saturday, August 12, 2023 at 3:00 pm in Crain Pleasant Grove-Murdale Funeral Home, 31 Memorial Dr., Murphysboro.
