Yvonne Blumenstock, age 92, formerly of Vergennes, passed away at 2:05 a.m. Friday, July 9, 2010, at the Jerseyville Manor, in Jerseyville, Illinois.

Yvonne was born on September 2, 1917, in Oraville, Illinois, to Shirley R. Ripley and Ida Mae (Talley) Ripley.

She was a resident of Vergennes, since the fall of 1937 until the late 1990's.
